PROGRAM SCRIPTURES

Intro—Kalvin Heck

On one special night, so many years ago, people rejoiced that Jesus had come into their world. Even though we can't see or touch Jesus, he is still in our world today, right with us. Jesus loves you and has chosen you to be his children. This is the story of how Jesus was born.

Part 1—from Luke chapter 1

A young women named Mary was alone one day. The Angel Gabriel suddenly appeared right in front of her. "Do not be afraid." Said the Angel. "God is pleased with you! Soon you will have a baby boy. His name will be Jesus. He will save God's people from their sins." "But how can this be?" Mary asked. "I can't have a baby if I'm not married." "God has a plan," Gabriel answered. "You will become pregnant by the power of the Holy Spirit. With God, nothing is impossible." Mary could not believe what she heard, but she trusted God. "I will do whatever God wants," she said. And soon, Mary met and became engaged to marry a man name Joseph.

THE CHRISTMAS STORY Part 1: from Luke 1 SONG "What Child is This?" (Verses 1 & 3)—

1 What child is this, who, laid to rest, on Mary's lap is sleeping? Whom angels greet with anthems sweet while shepherds watch are keeping?

Part 2—from Luke chapter 2 and Matthew 1 & 2
The Emperor wanted to know how many people lived in his land. He had everyone go to their hometowns to be counted. It was nighttime when Mary & Joseph got to Bethlehem. The little town was full of people. Every room at the inn was taken and the only place left for Mary & Joseph was a stable full of animals.

SONG "O Little Town of Bethlehem" (Verses 1 & 2)—

1 O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see you lie! Above thy deep and dreamless sleep the silent stars go by; Yet in your dark streets shines forth the everlasting light;, The hopes and fears of all the years are met in you tonight.

2 For Christ is born of Mary, and gathered all above, While mortals sleep, the angels keep their watch of wondering love.
O morning stars, together proclaim the holy birth!
And praises sing, and voices ring with peace to all on earth.

Part 3—continuation of part 2
There in the stable Joseph made a bed for Mary in the hay. Little did the world know the coolest, most awesome & amazing part of God's plan was happening! Jesus was ready to be born.

Part 3—continued

So there in the stillness of the night he came. Jesus was born! Jesus the one who would save the world from sin. Mary wrapped her new baby in soft clothes & laid him on some fresh hay in the animals feeding box called a manger.

<u>SONG</u> "Away in a Manger" (Verse 1 & 2 & 3)— Children sing verse 1

1 Away in a manger, no crib for a bed, the little Lord Jesus laid down his sweet head. The stars in the sky looked down where he lay, the little Lord Jesus, asleep on the hay.

Congregation Verse 2 & 3

2 The cattle are lowing, the poor baby wakes, but little Lord Jesus, no crying he makes. I love you, Lord Jesus; look down from the sky, and stay by my cradle until morning is nigh.

3 Be near me, Lord Jesus; I ask thee to stay close by me forever and love me, I pray.
Bless all the dear children in thy tender care, and take us to heaven to live with thee there and take us to heaven to live with thee there.

Part 4—from Luke chapter 2 verses 10-12
Meanwhile, that night, in the fields near Bethlehem
there were some shepherds guarding their sheep. All at
once a very bright light flashed in the sky. This
frightened the shepherds. Then many angels appeared.
An angel said, "Don't be scared! I have wonderful news
for you! Today in Bethlehem, a savior has been born for
you. He is Christ the Lord. You will know who he is
because you will find a baby dressed in soft clothes lying
in a manger."

SONG "Hark the Herald Angels Sing" (Verse 1 & 2)—

Refrain:

Hark! the herald angels sing, "Glory to the newborn king!"

2 Christ, by highest heaven adored, Christ, the everlasting Lord!
Late in time behold him come, offspring of the Virgin's womb.
Veiled in flesh the Godhead see; hail the incarnate Deity,
Pleased with man with us to dwell,
Jesus, our Emmanuel! [Refrain]

Part 4—continued

"Wow! That's Amazing!" The shepherds cheered! As soon as they found Jesus in Bethlehem they knelt down and worshiped him. Then they went out and spread the news about what the angels had told them. The Savior had come. "He's here, he's here!" They shouted.

<u>SONG</u> "Go Tell it on the Mountain" (Verse 1 & 2) Children sing verse 1

Go tell it on the mountain, over the hill and everywhere. Go tell it on the mountain that Jesus Christ is born!

1 While shepherds kept their watching o'er silent flocks by night, Behold throughout the heavens there shone a holy light. [Refrain]

Congregation verse 2

2 The shepherds feared and trembled when lo! above the earth Rang out the angel chorus that hailed our Savior's birth. [Refrain]

Part 5—from Matthew chapter 2

In the far east (that's land over by China) some wiseman saw a very bright star in the night sky. "It's a sign from God!" they thought. The wisemen followed the star on a very long journey to search for the new king of kings. The star led the wisemen to Bethlehem. There they found Jesus and his family in the stable. The wisemen brought Jesus gifts fit for a king: Gold, Frankincense, and Myrrh.

SONG "We Three Kings" (Verse 1 & 2)
